Special Meeting called to vote on school uniform possible changes

Call to Order and Welcome

Mr. Hall discussed survey results that reflects a change in uniform policy for the 2017-18 school year. Teachers, parents and students had the opportunity to vote which uniform option they would like to see our school turn to next year.

The online results overwhelming voted on Option 1.

The motion was made by Scott Shipsey and seconded by Don Martz to approve option 1 as the new uniform top choice for the 2017-18 school year. Members not present were contacted the next day to solicit option.

Results are posted below.

- 3 options were presented for dress code shirt colors:
 - Option 1—allow all colors, as long as solid
 - Option 2—allow solid colors of any of the Beaufort Cluster schools
 - Option 3—no changes
- 275 respondents
 - 91 parents
 - 138 students
 - 46 staff
- 174 of 275 combined selected option 1
 - 51 parents (56%), 102 students (73%), and 21 staff (45%)
- 59 of 275 combined selected option 2
 - 18 parents (19%), 33 students (23%), and 8 staff (17%)
- 42 of 275 combined selected option 3
 - 22 parents (22%), 3 students (2%), and 17 staff (36%)
- Parents options in order were 1, 3, 2 (56%, 24%, 19%)
- Student options in order were 1, 2, 3 (73%, 23%, 2%)
- Staff options in order were 1, 3, 2 (45%, 36%, 16%)
